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May the Bhagwan inspire humanity to follow the path of righteousness (Dharma). When people adhere to Dharma, the entire universe benefits. Since time immemorial, Bharat has been practicing Dharma, bringing well-being of the universe (*Lokah samastah sukhino bhavantu*). Whenever humanity loses its way due to the increased influence of demonic forces, making it difficult to follow Dharma, the Bhagwan incarnates to restore and uphold Dharma (*Yada yada hi dharmasya glanirbhavati bharata Abhythanamadharmasya tadatmanam srijamyaham*).

It is in Bharat that Sanatan Dharma is being practiced, and that is why the Bhagwan chooses to incarnate here in this holy place. This has led scholars all over the world to recognize Bharat as a *Vishwa guru* a nation worthy of respect throughout the world.

In creation, it is natural for humans to be more inclined toward evil forces when influenced by good and bad forces. Those who incite this evil are known as *Demons*.

In the **Treta Yuga**, the Supreme Being incarnated as Rama, practiced Dharma, and established **Rama Rajya** among the people of his kingdom. In the **Dwapara Yuga**, He incarnated as **Krishna**, vanquished the forces of Adharma (unrighteousness) through the teachings of Dharma, and re-established Dharma.

In this Kali Yuga, where Dharma is weak and struggles to maintain its presence, the reinstallation of Sri Rama in Ayodhya after 500 years, who embodies unified Dharma, will bring peace to the world.

Due to the current decline of Dharma, both internal and external, and the many calamities, internal wars and natural disasters. Kanchi Kamakshi Amma has ordered through her Temple's Chief priest Sri Suresh Sastry that a Rudra Sahita Chandi Yagam be performed in Ayodhya Dham (First of the seven most important pilgrimage places for Hindus) the birth place of Maryada Purushottam Bhagvan Sri



Ram to restore the peace. The scriptures also affirm that in Kali Yuga, the worship of Vinayaka and Chandi is especially powerful, as noted in the authoritative texts, "Kalau Chandi Vinayakau."

In the presence of Bhagwan Rama, performing the "*Sri Maha Narayana Divya Rudra Sahita Shata Sahasra Chandi Vishwa Shanti Maha Yagam*" will bring the Vishwa Shanti (World Peace), universal well-being, and inspire Dharma among the people.

Ayodhya, Kashi, and Kanchi, three ancient centers of knowledge and glory, share a bond that transcends time and the same has been referred to in **Upanishads and Puranas**. The connection between Kanchi and Ayodhya is mentioned in the 39th and 40th chapters of **Lalitopakhyanam**. It tells how Ayodhya's childless **King Dasharath** had a dream in which he was advised to visit Kanchi to pay respects to Goddess Kamakshi. King Dasharatha traveled 2000 km from Ayodhya to Kanchi in the **Treta Yug** to seek the blessings of **Goddess Kamakshi**. He performed the **"Putra Kameshti Yagam"** in Ayodhya, later being blessed with four illustrative sons, including Bhagwan Ram. Goddess Kamakshi is also the **Kuldevi (clan deity)** of the Ikshvaku clan, as mentioned in the **Markandeya Purana**.

The bond between Kanchi and Ayodhya is also mentioned in the Brahmanda Purana. Kanchi and Ayodhya are mentioned as Prithvi Kshetram among the Pancha Bhutha Stalam of Bhagwan Siva.

The relation between Kanchi and Ayodhya is mentioned among the 'Pancha Bhuta Sthalam' (temples dedicated to elements of nature) of Bhagwan Shiva, where Kanchi and Ayodhya areas are referred to as 'Prithvi Kshetram'. These two cities are also among the seven centers for attaining Moksha (liberation from the cycle of birth and death), including Ayodhya, Mathura, Maya (Mayapuri or Haridwar), Kashi (Varanasi), Kanchi (Kanchipuram), Avantika (Ujjain) and Dwaravati (Dwaraka). **This Yagna is being** performed at the birth place of Bhagwan Rama, who established "**Rama Rajya**" the ideal state of society as envisioned by Bhagwan Rama "**Maryada Purushottam**", comprising perfect harmony, justice, dharma and prosperity, where people lived in peace and happiness, which in modern times called "**Antyodaya**" (upliftment of the poor).

The *Rudra Sahita Chandi Yagam* is a prominent and powerful yagam in Hinduism, revered for its comprehensive benefits. By performing this yagam, one can invoke the divine energies of Goddess Chandi and Bhagwan Rudra, offering a powerful solution for various life challenges. This is an ancient ritual that helped to protect the environment and purify the air.

By performing this *yagam*, everyone can:

- Overcome obstacles and doshas (negative energies)
- Alleviate health issues and cure serious illnesses

This grand Vishwashanti Maha Yagam is a magnificent and sacred event that will be conducted continuously for 57 days, starting from

November 2nd, 2024 (Saturday) Ankurarpana and
Concluding on December 28th, 2024 (Saturday).

As part of this Yagam, various sacred rituals will be performed, including Chaturveda Parayanam, Havanams, Panchayatan worship of deities such as Ganapati, Sudarshana, Narasimha Chandi, Vanadurga Mahavidyas, and many other Anushthanams (rituals), Surya Namaskarams, Sahasra Lingarchanams, Navagraha Mantra Anushthanams, Subrahmanya Mantra Anushthanams, Sri Rama Taraka, Anjaneya Maha Mantra Anushthanams, Srimad Ramayana, Devi Bhagavata Parayanams, and Dasha Koti Chandi Navarna Mula Mantra Anushthanams.



and other important parayanams will be rendered during the process of yagam both in the morning and evening sessions.

On the Last day there will be **Mahapoornahuthi**. This shudda jalam will be taken to the Ayodhya Bhagwan Sri ram and with this holy water there will be Avabrutha snanam to the Bhagwan. (The entire power generated during the 57 days mahayagnam will be transferred on to Bhagwan Sri Rama deity).

The Supreme Being is the infinite light, the same as the Atmajyoti (light of the soul) and the great energy. This light permeates countless millions of universes. The word "Shiva" is derived by reversing the syllables of "Vashi." This infinite light is Shiva, its energy is Parashakti, and its expanse is Mahavishnu. This is the essence of the Nigama and Agama Vedas, which indicate the inseparable connection between these three divine entities.

- The Divine Rudra Yagam is dedicated to the infinite light of the Supreme Being, Shiva.
- The Shata Sahasra Chandi Yagam is dedicated to the infinite light of Parashakti.
- The Maha Narayana Yagam is dedicated to the infinite light that permeates countless universes, Mahavishnu.

PANCHARATNA GHOSTI: The final day a pancharatna ghosti ganam by Vidwans of our country in the divine abode of Maryada Purushottam Bhagwan Sri Rama.

These programs will be held exclusively on this stage, dedicated to showcasing India's rich cultural heritage through music and spiritual expression.

Cultural Programs will be held under the supervision of "Sri Vidya Poorna Deeksha" "Agama Abhigna," "Dhananjaya", the son of Brahmarshi Yanamandra Venu Gopala Shastri Garu, Dr. Yanamandra Srinivasa Sharma Garu, also known as "Neelakanta Anandhanatha.

We request all to be a part of this extraordinary event, included in this spiritual celebrations resonating with the vibrations of Sri Ram, Bhagwan Siva, and Goddess Chandi. May their blessings bring health, peace, and prosperity to all families for generations to come.
